

Digi-Troll II Overview

The Digi-troll II downrigger was produced from 1987-1992. It was first introduced as a Marlin DTII, available in black, before being made both in white and black. It is the same downrigger as the original Digi-Troll, with aesthetic changes to the keypad as the only difference. This downrigger would allow you to program 2 different depths into memory, and go automatically to the depth by pressing a button on a keypad. It also offered an Auto-Up feature. By pressing the Auto-Up button, it would retrieve the weight automatically, stopping at the water level. You could also program the downrigger to cycle up and down between two depths.

Features:

Allows you to store two depths for quick reference and recovery

Auto-Up retrieval brings the weight up out of the water automatically, stopping at water level

Downrigger will cycle between two depths at various time periods that you select

Does not bottom track.
